On April 25, 1934, after two years of protests, the Southern Pacific Railroad closed the Dayton Depot and the original C&C RR line from Mound House to Churchill.

Join us exactly 75 years later at Dayton's historic 1881 Carson & Colorado Depot (Hwy. 50E and Main St.) for a "meet and greet"—to learn about our depot restoration project, tour the depot, and get acquainted with members of the Historical Society of Dayton Valley.
